# Speed and quality

“What does SQ stand for? Speed and Quality, of course,” answered Dehler’s CEO, Wilan van den Berg. The SQ range was introduced in 2004, first with the 39SQ and later the 36SQ. This is the first new yacht to exit the German yard since Van den Berg took over in 2005, and could be an interesting pointer to the future.



Vinylester construction has reduced the weight of the hull by 500kg compared with the original 47, but it’s the second part of the phrase on which this boat really focuses – quality.

The first hull will be Van den Berg’s private yacht and no expense has been spared – carbon-fibre spars, winches, wheel, blocks and passerelle add to flush-mounted hatches, LED navigation lights and folding cleats to make an impressive inventory. Below decks Dehler offer a customisable layout, with touch-screen electronics and brushed metal appliances.
